ANDREW MEINHOLD is Newest Lake County ADAMHS Board Member

The Lake County Board of Commissioners have appointed Andrew Meinhold as the newest member of the Lake County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board. He was sworn in by Commissioner Daniel Troy during the board's regular August 21 meeting in Painesville.

Established by Ohio statute, the ADAMHS Board plans, monitors, and funds Lake County's network of services for residents with a mental illness and/or addiction disorders. Those services are delivered through a network of providers. Board members are all Lake County residents who serve without compensation.

Meinhold has been in the banking industry for nearly 40 years, and is currently Senior Vice President for ERIEBANK, a division of CNB Bank. He is responsible for the bank's Lake County market including strategic planning, business development and community involvement. Previously he was President/ CEO of Lake National Bank, until its acquisition by CNB in 2016.

The Concord Township resident serves as a trustee for Leadership Lake County and was named that organization's Leader of the Year in 2016. He also serves on the board of directors for the Lake County Development Council and the Lakeland Foundation, and is a member and past president of Mentor Rotary Club.




