

### Lantern offers special, caring assistance for elderly

MADISON TOWN- levels of care offered. Lev-SHIP - When aging persons can no longer live on their own, the Lantern, with locations in Madison Township, Saybrook and Chagrin Valley, offers different levels of care, as needed.

The mission at the Lantern is "to facilitate healthy living, provide superior services consistent with the needs of the elderly, offer an environment that will support their personal needs and create an atmosphere that will stimulate creativity and enhance performance to their maximum potential. We are committed to providing a desired place that will physically, mentally and emotionally satisfy the seniors."

Shannon Reglus, director of marketing and communications at Lantern of Madison, said many people think the Lantern only cares for those with dementia, but that is un-

There are actually four

el 1 is independent with laundry, housekeeping and meals provided. Level 2 includes nursing care.

Level 3 is hands-on care with assistance in daily activities. Level 4 is hospice and total care.

Reglus noted the Lantern in Saybrook has the same look of a 30s and 40s neighborhood for both assisted living and the memory care (Svayus) units. In Madison, the assisted living area is like a hotel, while the memory care unit looks like a neighborhood.

"We focus on a personality-centered approach to care, so not a personcentered approach, which is traditional," Reglus said. "We really dig into our clients—like how they grew up, what was their family, did they have pets, who were their friendsit's really important for us to get to know our clients on a really personal level."

Svayus, an ancient Sanskrit word, means "life with vigor," she said.

The Lantern's programs have helped clients improve their memory and attention so they are able to manage daily living tasks such as bathing, dressing and grooming. The ability to do those things is important for the clients' dignity, Reglus

The activities offered help to ward off memory loss by keeping them physically and mentally active.

While Alzheimer's disease and dementia cannot be reversed, there are ways to slow the progression, Reglus said. The main goal at the Lantern is to help those clients maintain their dignity.

Things like having a picture of the client outside their room helps them find their "home" on their

The Lantern also likes to keep its clients socially active by taking them to events out in the community and on weekly shopping trips.



At The Lantern in Madison, the memory care unit looks like a neighborhood.

Reglus said there is a reluctance on the part of many when asked to consider assisted living. However, clients have their own apartments and privacy, but with the added benefit of readily available assistance should they need it.

"We really want our

families to be involved in the care planning process, so we appreciate that a lot," Reglus said.

Personally, she enjoys seeing clients settle in and begin to enjoy their lives at the Lantern.
