Matt Sabo is the newest member of the Lake County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board. He was appointed by the Lake County Board of Commissioners, and was sworn in during the board's regular September 17 meeting.

Established by Ohio statute, the ADAMHS Board plans, monitors, and funds Lake County's network of services for residents with a mental illness and/or substanceuse disorders. Those services are delivered through a network of providers. Board members are all Lake County residents who serve without compensation.



Sabo is Chief of the Concord Township Fire Department. He has been with that organization since 1999 in capacities including firefighter/paramedic, EMS coordinator, and lieutenant. He serves on Lake County's Opiate Task Force, and

coordinator, and lieutenant. He serves on Lake County's Oplate Task Force, and

helped plan and coordinate Lake County's Quick Response Team. Sabo holds a degree in Public Safety Management from Franklin University, and an Associate of Applied Science in Fire Protection Technology degree from the University of Akron.

Historic Water Tower Is Getting A Fresh Coat



The Lake County Visitors Bureau and the Madison Community Improvement Corporation (MCIC) have teamed to save the historic Madison Village (OH) water tower. Rather than dirt and shovels, on October 15, 2018 at 10:00 am, the community is invited to grab a paint brush to commemorate the beginning of the Grand River Valley / Madison Water Tower Restoration Project. The collaboration behind saving this 90 year-old structure is county wide. In addition to MCIC and the Lake County Visitors Bureau, the result of this preservation project has been made possible through the generous support of Lake County Commissioners' Jerry Cirino, John Hamercheck, and Dan Troy, Madison Village Council and Mayor Britton, Madison Village Merchants, and through numerous private and corporate donations.

"This joint effort began in July 2017 when Dwayne and I met for the first time," said Scott H. Dockus, Executive Director Lake County Visitors Bureau. "Instantly we both

new this iconic symbol of Remarkable Lake County, OH needed to be saved and set forth actions to save it," Dockus said. "Through joint fundraising campaigns spearheaded by MCIC and together with the Lake County Visitors Bureau, we raised over \$30,000 for phase one of the project" said Dwayne Bailey, Madison (OH) Village Administrator. "The restoration will be completed in three stages; repair of the tower and a white base coat will be completed fall 2018, in spring 2019 branding art will be applied to the bowl, as well as landscaping to create a welcome area on the 528/I90 exit," added Bailey.

Located in Remarkable Lake County, OH and the heart of Ohio's Grand River Valley Region, the water tower will be the destination symbol of the Grand River Valley Region. In addition to the water tower restoration and welcome area, a new Holiday Inn Express and Hampton Inn are being added to the 528/I90 exit which are also scheduled for a spring 2019 opening.



Workers' Compensation Update

2019 Experience Rating changes for private employers

Over the last several months, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) and their actuarial consultants have been reviewing how rates are calculated for private employers in an effort to better match premium with costs.

Based on the actuarial consultants' analysis, the BWC Board of Directors recently approved the following changes in regards to how BWC premium is calculated for private employers effective with the July 1, 2019 rating year.

1. Maximum claim limit reductions for smaller employers

Employers that are small in size with expected losses below \$15,000 will see a reduction in their maximum claim limit. This is in an effort to reduce the impact of one "large" claim to a small employer's premium rates.

2. Experience Modification Rate adjustment factor

BWC has introduced a factor that will be applied to an individual employer's Experience Modification Rate (EMR). An employer's EMR is a number used to gauge both past cost of injuries and future chances of risk. The lower the EMR for your business, the lower your workers' compensation premium will be. Employers with a better than average EMR (EMR of 0.90 and lower) will see a 5% reduction, while employers with the worst EMR's in the state will see a 5% increase.

3. Premium size factor

BWC introduced a second factor that will be applied based on the amount of premium an employer pays into the fund. Individual merit-rated employers with premium in excess of \$5,000 will most likely see a reduction in premium.

The changes listed do not apply to public employers (counties, cities, villages, townships, schools, etc.), private employers participating in a group rating program or those employers enrolled in a Professional Employer Organization (PEO). This group of employers will not see any change to how premium is calculated.

In light of these changes, it is recommended to review your 2019 program options closely as now is the time to enroll in these programs. Updates to the BWC premium calculations may impact which BWC program is most advantageous for your organization.




